PACE OF PLAY—READY GOLF

Playing at a better pace is not about hurrying up or rushing around the course. It is simply about being more efficient with your valuable time, as well as everyone else's. Adopting this mindset – and not being afraid to share it with your fellow players – will ultimately add enjoyment to your golf experience. Here are some recognized tips for improving pace of play:

MINIMIZE YOUR TIME ON THE TEE

On the tee it is usually acceptable for players to “hit when ready.”

PLAN YOUR SHOT BEFORE YOU GET TO YOUR BALL

Once you are off the tee, think ahead. Determine your yardage and make your club selection before it is your turn to play.

KEEP YOUR PRE-SHOT ROUTINE SHORT

Pick your line of play once and trust yourself. Most importantly, be ready to hit when it is your turn. Start moving toward your next shot promptly.

DEVELOP AN EYE FOR DISTANCE

You don't have to step off yardage for every shot. If you need to determine precise distance, try to find a yardage marker before you reach your ball or use a range finder.

WHEN SHARING A CART, USE THE BUDDY SYSTEM

Don't wait in the cart while your cart partner hits and then drive to your ball. Get out and walk to your ball with a few clubs. Be ready to play when it is your turn.

If others you are playing with are not familiar with the course, the Rules permit players to exchange yardage information without penalty.

BE HELPFUL TO OTHERS IN YOUR GROUP

Follow the flight of all tee shots, not just your own. Once in the fairway, help others look for their ball if you already know the location of yours. Volunteer to fill in a divot or rake a bunker for another player if needed. Be ready to attend the flagstick for others.

KEEP UP WITH THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU

Your correct position on the course is immediately behind the group in front of you, not immediately in front of the group behind you. **AIM TO PLAY IN 40 SECONDS.** From club selection to pre-shot routine to execution, strive to hit your shot in 40 seconds when it is your turn to play. Help keep play moving at a brisk pace. Keep up with group in front of you.

BE EFFICIENT ON THE PUTTING GREEN

Mark your ball, lift and clean it when you arrive at the putting green so you will be ready to replace it when it is your turn to play. You can usually line up your putt while others are putting, without disturbing them. Leave your clubs on the side of the putting green closest to the next tee, and leave the green promptly after holing out. Wait until the next tee to record your score. Leave the green after you have holed your ball and proceed to the next tee and hit.

SUNDAY FUNDAY

Tournaments are played one Sunday each month, with tee times from

7:00-10:45 a.m.

- Play is open to all “active” members in good standing, plus one guest.
- Each foursome must have a minimum of two (2) CWGC members, unless otherwise specified.
- All guests must have an active GHIN/USGA handicap
- All players must be 18 years of age or older.
- Monthly signups for any given Funday are at 5:00pm, on the Sunday two weeks before the Funday event.
(Example: If you are signing up for January 25th Funday, the signup date is two weeks before on January 11th at 5:00pm.)
- \$15 per player buy-in

SWEEPS

Sweeps will be played Tuesdays (18 holes) on non-tournament days. All members playing on Tuesdays will participate in Sweeps. A minimum of 16 players must complete the round to validate the game.

Members must play with at least one other member to qualify to win any prize money.

Signup for Sweeps. Sunday beginning at 7:00AM, 16 days before the Tuesday play day, email the Sweeps Chair at cwgc.teetimes@gmail.com

1. For play before 8:00AM, the member may sign up herself and one other member.
 2. For play 8:00AM or after, the member may sign up herself and up to a foursome.
- Sweeps information will be emailed to members prior to Tuesday play day. Scoring, posting and ringer will be done through Golf Genius.

Tee Sheet/Cancellations:

All tee times will be done through the sweeps email at: cwgc.teetimes@gmail.com until Saturday at 5:00PM, allowing the Sweeps Chairs to fill cancellations made on Friday by 5:00PM and to prevent outside play. (Do not call the Pro Shop unless you have a late cancellation Sunday, Monday or Tuesday.)

SWEEPS PAYOUTS

Low Gross, Low Net, CTP's & Chip Ins

- Cancellation deadline: is still **Friday by 5:00PM**, before the Tuesday play day.
- After 5:00PM on Saturday the remaining tee times will be released to the Pro Shop for the public.
Late cancellations/Not Playing on Tuesday when scheduled: Cancellations made on Sunday, Monday or Tuesday must be made by calling the Pro Shop at (619) 522-6590 and will be charged a \$10 cancellation fee.
- This cancellation fee is per person and includes any guests that you have signed up. **Only exception is a Medical Emergency or Injury.** Please email Betsy Andersen (bandersen57@hotmail.com).
- In addition, if your fine has not been settled by the next sweeps date, you will lose your sign-up privileges and your name will be removed from the tee sheet.
