Stroke & Distance New Local Rule

Lost Ball or Out of Bounds

Local Alternative Rule To Stroke-and-distance for Out of Bounds and Lost Ball (MLR 8E-5):
This alternative dropping rule is only available if you DO NOT HIT A PROVISIONAL BALL.

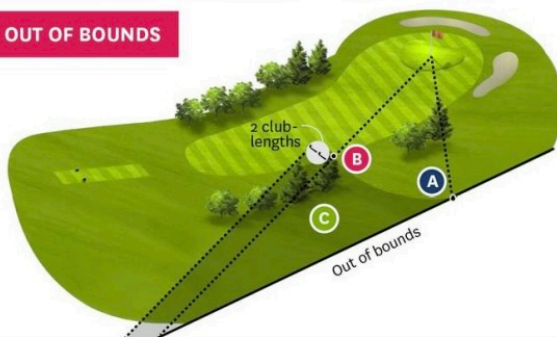
As shown on the diagram on the left, find the point where the ball last crossed out of bounds (Point A). From Point A, determine the point on the fairway that is no nearer the hole (Point B plus two club-lengths into the fairway). You may drop anywhere within the shaded Area C for a penalty of 2 strokes. The alternative drop rule is identical for a lost ball as shown in the diagram on the right.

Example: Tee shot might be lost or out of bounds. You play a provisional ball under the original Stroke-and-Distance rule. You are hitting 3 from the tee. If you determine your ball is out of bounds or lost then the provisional ball is the ball in play and is lying 3. If you did not hit a provisional ball then your options are dropping as shown in the diagrams below or going back to the tee box to hit again. Either way, you will be lying 3.

GOLF'S NEW RULES: STROKE AND DISTANCE

A new Local Rule provides an alternative to stroke-and-distance relief for a ball that is lost outside a penalty area or out of bounds, effective January 1, 2019.

BALL OUT OF BOUNDS



If the Local Rule is in effect, you can still take stroke-and-distance relief, but you now have the following additional option that comes with a penalty of two strokes:

A DETERMINE SPOT where your ball went out of bounds (left diagram) or is likely to be lost (right diagram).

B FIND NEAREST FAIRWAY EDGE no closer to the hole.

LOST BALL



C DROP YOUR BALL IN SHADED AREA as defined on one side by a line from the hole through point A and on the other side by a line from the hole through point B, and not nearer the hole. The relief area is extended on both sides by two club-lengths.

This Local Rule is not intended for higher levels of play, such as professional or elite amateur level competitions.
