Coronado Bridge Traffic**

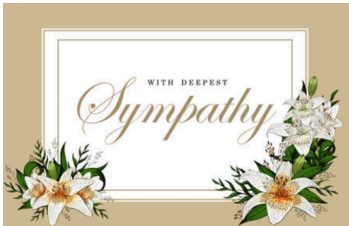

## **RULES CORNER**

**Lark Herrick Rules Chair**

### **New local rule - Tree Roots in Short Mown Area:**

**Interference from exposed tree roots in the short mown area and within one club length of the short mown area are treated as ground under repair whether marked or not. Free relief under Rule 16.1b. (mlr 8F-9)**

**Be sure to pick up a new copy of the local rules in the clubroom so you always have it handy.**

### **Pace of Play Reminders:**

- 1. Never stand near the green after everyone has completed play on the hole. Move to the next tee box quickly and mark your scores there.**
- 2. When you hit your shot, move if no one else is playing nearby! There's no need to clean & put your clubs away immediately.**
- 3. Leave your extra clubs between you and your cart so you'll pick them up when walking towards your cart.**  
**\*\*\*Getting out of the way quickly allows those behind you to hit up. There's nothing worse than watching people ahead clean their clubs, put them away, mark the scores and then move. Move first! Do the rest later.**
- 4. If you're sharing a power cart, drop off a player at her shot and then move to your shot to prepare if it is safe.**
- 5. Avoid walking back and forth. If you need a distance measurement, take several clubs with you so you don't need to walk back to your cart for a club.**
- 6. Always park your cart nearest where you'll walk off the green. Position it so you do not need to walk back towards the players behind you. (Obviously, Hole 8 is an exception)**
- 7. If you're falling behind, send two players to the next tee to tee off on the next hole while the other two are finishing.**
- 8. Remember - you're only allowed 40 seconds to hit your shot. Start thinking about your next shot while you approach it. Determine your distance, read the putt, determine the club and shot you need while others are playing so you're ready when it's your turn. You can do this without disturbing the other player.**
