

Standing Rules for Sweeps

Sweeps will be played on Tuesday (18 Holes) on non- tournament days.

All members playing on Tuesdays will participate in Sweeps.

A minimum of 16 players must complete the round to validate the game.

If the game is not validated due to rain, then the \$10 cancellation fee will not be collected.

Signups for Sweeps:

- Sunday begins at 7:00 a.m., 16 days before the Tuesday play day, email cwgc.teetimes@gmail.com with your requests.
- For play scheduled before 8:00 a.m., you may register yourself and one additional member.
- For play scheduled at 8:00 a.m. or after 8:00 a.m., you may register yourself and up to a foursome.

Open Tee Times Registration (OTT)

After the tee sheet has been populated by the Sweeps Team with your email requests, the tee sheet will be made available to the membership by Sunday evening through the “Open Tee Times Registration (OTT)” feature in the Member Portal, where you can manage your own bookings. The Member Portal can be accessed from the [cwgcgolf.net website](http://cwgcgolf.net) or [Golf Genius mobile application](#) and login with your email and password is required. You can view and make changes, such as adding yourself to an available spot, rescheduling or canceling your tee times.

At 5:00 p.m. on Friday before Tuesday play day, the tee sheet will automatically close and OTT **will not** be available for any modifications by you. Please refer to Cancellations/No-Shows/Changes instructions.

- Members will receive an email with Sweeps information (tip sheet) prior to Tuesday play day.
- Scoring, posting and Ringers management will be handled through Golf Genius.
- Sweeps payouts will be paid through the Pro Shop.

Payouts

Payouts are \$10 for one Gross in each flight and seven Nets - \$10, \$9, \$8, \$7, \$6, \$5, \$4 - in each flight. Chip-ins are \$2 each and CTPs are \$5.

Payouts are subject to change by vote of the Executive Board.

Members must play with at least one other member to qualify for sweeps and to win any prize money.

Cancellations/No-shows/Changes

- Cancellations deadline is Friday by 5:00 p.m. before Tuesday play day:
Please use OTT to cancel your tee time before the deadline to avoid incurring a cancellation fee.
- Cancellations after 5:00 p.m. and non-attendance (no show) on Tuesday when scheduled will incur a \$10 cancellation fee. This cancellation fee is for per person and includes any guests whom you may have registered.
- Only exception is a Medical Emergency or injury.

- Cancellations or changes between Friday 5:00 p.m. and Saturday 5:00 p.m. :
Please email Sweeps Team. This will allow the Sweeps Team to fill cancellations and prevent outside play.
- Cancellations made between Saturday evening, Sunday, Monday and Tuesday :
Please call the Pro Shop at (619) 522-6590 and please follow with an email to the Sweeps Team advising them with your modifications done with the Pro Shop.

Loss of Sweeps Privileges :

- If the cancellation fee is not settled by the next Sweeps date, you will lose your sign-up privileges and your name will be removed from the tee sheet.
- Please pay your cancellation fee via the following methods :-
- **Venmo and Zelle are the preferred methods.**
- Venmo to Coronado Women's Golf Club [@CoronadoWomens-GolfClub](https://www.venmo.com/CoronadoWomens-GolfClub)
or
- **Zelle** through your bank to cwgc.board@gmail.com
or
- **By check** – please drop your check in the **drop box** located in the foyer of the club house (across from the trophies glass case).
- Please add a memo to your method of payment noting what the payment is for. In this case, it will be cancellation fee for (insert date)
- Please notify the Sweeps Team by email that payment has been made.

Monies collected from the cancellation fees are added to the Sweeps payouts.

Invited Guests :

- You can register by email to Sweeps up to three guests on Wednesday, a week in advance of Tuesday play day, based on availability.
- To qualify for Sweeps, you must have two members in the foursome.
- Guests will not be scored on Golf Genius and will be responsible for posting their own scores.
- Guests are limited to **once per quarter** regardless if they are invited by another member.
- If you cancel your tee time, your guests or guests must cancel too.
- Guests are limited to **Ladies** as it is **Ladies day**.

Rules, Policies and Guidelines Governing Slow Play :

- Rule 6-7 Undue Delay. The player shall play without undue delay. Between completion of a hole and playing from the next teeing ground, the player shall not unduly delay play.
- Your correct position on the course is immediately behind the group in front of you.
- Reports from the Marshall or any CWGC member regarding slow play will be verified and followed up with a verbal warning.
- IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THESE SLOW PLAY GUIDELINES, A MEMBER OF THE RULES COMMITTEE SHALL NOT TOLERATE DISRESPECT, ORAL OR OTHERWISE, BY A PLAYER. SUCH DISRESPECT MAY CONSTITUTE CONDUCT UNBECOMING OF A CWGC MEMBER. DISRESPECT TOWARD A MARSHALL SHALL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION.
- Players are required to arrive 30 minutes before their scheduled tee time.

Handicaps :

- Handicaps are updated every Sunday morning and handicaps from that day will be used for Tuesday play.

Tuesday Pairings :

- The pairings for Tuesday will be based on the tee sheet as of 5:00 p.m. on Saturday.
- The pairings and tip sheets will be emailed to everyone on the tee sheet before Tuesday play day.
- The pairings sheet will show the unique GGID assigned to your foursome. You can use it to **login to the Golf Genius app**. Or you can also login with your email or password.

Ringers :

- Ringer is an eclectic “tournament” wherein members ‘hole-by-hole scores are improved over a period of three months.
- Ringer series:
 - 1st Quarter Ringer – January through March
 - 2nd Quarter Ringer – April through June
 - 3rd Quarter Ringer – July through September
 - 4th Quarter Ringer – October through December
- Scores from Sweeps, Sunday Fundays and CWGC Events will be accepted. The tournaments using magic putts or mulligans will not be included in Ringers.
- The player’s index at the beginning of the series will be used for flighting. The handicap for each round will be used for determining the score for each hole.
- Flight winners will be declared after the last round of the Ringer series.
- Golf Genius will handle the scoring. There is no need to fill out a separate scorecard,
- The entry fee is \$16 for the year and it is due by January 1st of the current year.
- Preferred payment method : **Venmo or Zelle**
