## FEEDBACK ON LADIES TEMPORARY TEE BOXES

For those Ladies that played the temporary tees, the weather conditions did not give everyone a chance to finish and give their feedback. We are planning to try another date, **April 18th**. Since this is a play day after the course has been aerated and will still be recovering, it will be a good time to try the forward tees.

The game that day will be **Field Shots**: Count all strokes taken before reaching the green. You may choose not to putt or if you do make sure you subtract your putts from the gross score of the hole. **Enter only the strokes taken to reach the green into Golf Genius.**

\* Your scores will not be posted and will not count towards Ringer, as putting is not required.

\* Hole-In-Ones, Eagles or Par Club will not count or be paid.

Our CGC Advisory chair will be presenting the feedback we already have received at the March CGC Advisory Meeting.

Remember this will be a process and the more feedback we give the golf course Superintendent, it will help them decide on their course of action. For those low handicappers there will be a recommendation to have two sets of tees.

## GUEST PROCEDURES

**Invited Guests** - Invited guests can be signed up on Wednesday, one week in advance. You can invite up to three guests, based on availability. **All Guests are limited to once every quarter.** To qualify for sweeps you must have two members in the foursome. If the member cancels the guest must cancel. If the member and guest cancel after 5:00 pm on Friday or do not play on Tuesday when scheduled they will be charged a \$10 fee per member and guests. Member is responsible for all cancellation fees. Guests are limited to **LADIES** as it is ladies day.

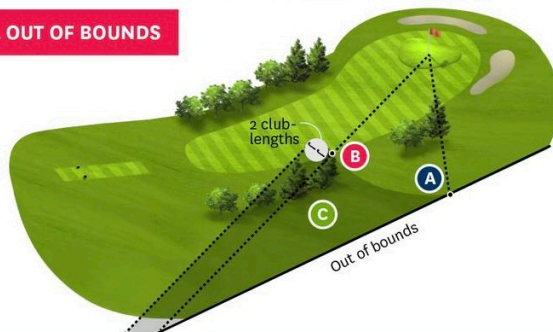

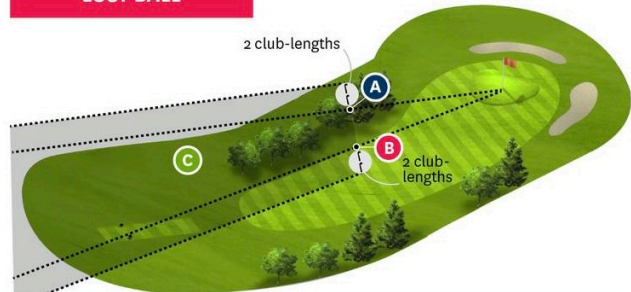
### GOLF'S NEW RULES: STROKE AND DISTANCE

A new Local Rule provides an alternative to stroke-and-distance relief for a ball that is lost outside a penalty area or out of bounds, effective January 1, 2019.

#### BALL OUT OF BOUNDS



#### LOST BALL



If the Local Rule is in effect, you can still take stroke-and-distance relief, but you now have the following additional option that comes with a penalty of two strokes:

**A** **DETERMINE SPOT** where your ball went out of bounds (left diagram) or is likely to be lost (right diagram).

**B** **FIND NEAREST FAIRWAY EDGE** no closer to the hole.

**C** **DROP YOUR BALL IN SHADED AREA** as defined on one side by a line from the hole through point A and on the other side by a line from the hole through point B, and not nearer the hole. The relief area is extended on both sides by two club-lengths.

This Local Rule is not intended for higher levels of play, such as professional or elite amateur level competitions.
