## STANDING RULES - HANDICAP

The Coronado Women's Golf Club (CWGC) utilizes Golf Genius(GG) "Live Scoring" for all events. As a member you will need to add the Golf Genius app to your Smartphone by downloading the app from the App Store or Play Store. The instructions for Golf Genius Live Scoring can be found on the CWGC website. In addition to using Live Scoring, each foursome must record scores on a Scorecard for verification purposes. At the end of each round please verify the scores entered into GG Live Scoring by verifying hole-by-hole against the scorecard. CTP and Chip Ins get emailed to cwgc.teetimes@gmail.com, please indicate players name, hole \# and distance. The scores entered into GG Live Scoring are posted to your GHIN record utilizing USGA Handicap protocols. Therefore, it is not necessary for you to post score when playing on Tuesdays, Sunday Fundays or any CWGC event.
Ties will be broken according to the USGA rules (ie: back nine, then front nine).
If you have not done so already, you should also download the GHIN app to your smartphone for easy access to your GHIN records. It is still necessary for you to post your scores when playing at other courses that does not utilize GG Live Scoring. There are also many features in the GHIN app: one of which is the Handicap Calculator which you can use to calculate your Handicap when playing other courses. A member's handicap index will update daily, provided the member submitted a score the day before. Otherwise, no update will take place. If your email address is in the SCGA database, you'll receive an automated notification of your index.

Each year in December, typically at the Holiday Scramble, the Club presents an annual "Most Improved" award of \$75. To be considered the player must be a CWGC Member for 12 months and have participated in Sweeps or Tournaments a total of 12 or more times during December 1st through November 30th. The recipient may not have had a modified index due to injury/illness during this timeframe.

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
